The subject of school dress is an important factor in the development of attitudes, behavior and academic achievement. All students should attend school dressed in a manner which is clean, is not hazardous to their safety or the safety of others, and which does not detract from the educational environment. Specific recommendations on school dress are presented in each school's Student Handbook; however, discretion and good judgment should be exercised in all phases of planning a school wardrobe. School officials have no intention of dictating the quality of specific types of clothing to be worn but will reserve the right to govern the mode of dress and grooming.
