Emergency Alarm Test Tomorrow Tomorrow, Wednesday, October 4, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) will conduct a nationwide emergency alert test on all consumer cell phones. The test will occur at approximately 2:20 PM and will coincide with a test of the Emergency Broadcast System on radios and televisions. This information is being shared for your awareness. - 3. Enrollment Increasing Our enrollment numbers have increased by 9% since the 2020-2021 school year and continue to rise! We are currently up to approximately 990 students!
