

Dear Riverview Parents,

We hope you had a relaxing and enjoyable break! We have a few more weeks until another significant break, so let's finished December strong! We wanted to reach out on a few important items prior to the students returning to school tomorrow:

- Vaccination (Flu and Covid) Clinic Partnership with Plum The infection counts in the County are spiking significantly and just this week many of us have had loved ones either pass away or get seriously ill (hospitalizations, etc.) from the virus. The Health Department and medical community are watching this new variant (Omicron) very carefully and continue to advocate for vaccinations and masks to be worn indoors. Please know that the primary reason we continue to push vaccinations is because we genuinely care about you, your family, and your children. None of us want anyone we care about (you) to experience serious illness because of the virus. The secondary reason, as previously discussed, is because the vaccination helps us to avoid contact tracing protocols and keep students in school where they belong. The most susceptible to the virus are the unvaccinated. If you haven't done so, the Health Department is asking that all of us schedule the booster shot and the Flu shot as well. Both are quick and easy, and most of us have not experienced any side effects whatsoever. We will continue to do our best to make it easier for those to become vaccinated if they so choose. In line with that, we are once again partnering with the Plum School District for an additional vaccination clinic. This clinic is for anyone five (5) years of age or older and is being held from 6-9pm in the Plum Senior High School cafeteria on Tuesday, November 30th and Tuesday, December 21st. Please note, for days that require a full closure, we will be utilizing virtual instruction that will run on a **two-hour delay** schedule so that teachers and students can prepare and transition accordingly. More details will come from your building principal and teachers when these events become necessary.
