

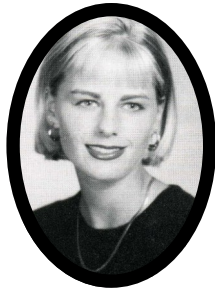

Lynsie Campbell

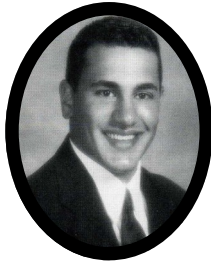
Riverview High School Class of 1996
