



Dear Riverview Parents,

This is our first week after the time change last weekend and we hope you are enjoying the warmer weather and longer days. Below are two important items for your consideration this week:

1. **Important Snow Day Announcement** – Due to legislation passed in Pennsylvania allowing schools to adjust each year based on annual instructional hour requirements (which Riverview significantly surpasses), the Riverview Board of Education has voted unanimously to **not require the makeup days for the “traditional” snow day this year and in future years to come.** As a result, there is **NO SCHOOL** for students and staff on **Thursday, March 28th**. This extends Spring Break by one day, beginning on Thursday, March 28th, and extending through Wednesday, April 3rd. Classes will resume on Thursday, April 4th. We commend the board for their continued focus on our community's needs while providing a clearer and more consistent schedule that balances our children's education with valuable family time. We hope you will enjoy the extended break. 2. **COVID-19 Changes** – The CDC has changed its recommendations for COVID-19.
