1. **4<sup>th</sup> Marking Period**– As many of you know, the Board voted in favor of the administration’s 4<sup>th</sup> marking period instructional recommendation, which includes a 100% in-person option and a 100% virtual option. Thank you for completing your selection survey last week. For the few parents that have still not responded, please call and let us know which option you choose so that we can prepare our spaces accordingly.
