

Dear Riverview Parents,

Good afternoon! We hope you are happy and well! As we steadily approach spring break, we wanted to reach out to you prior to this Thursday with a few important items:

- Spring Break Reminder Remember, there is NO SCHOOL beginning this Thursday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, and extending through Monday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022. School will resume on Tuesday, April 19<sup>th</sup>. We hope you will enjoy a much-needed break full of family, friends, and good times! We know it will be well received and deserved!
- 2. Free Covid-19 At Home Tests Our State Covid-19 testing partner has provided free at home tests for all Riverview families. We have enough supply for at least one box (each containing two tests) for each student. If you are interested, each school nurse will set up outside of the front entrance at each school tomorrow afternoon. The times are listed below. If we have extra supply, we can plan for additional pickup times after the holiday break as well. This is completely optional, of course, but is a nice courtesy to our Riverview families:
- Verner Elementary School 2:45pm 3:10pm Outside of the front entrance

• **10**<sup>th</sup> **Street Elementary School** – 2:45pm – 3:10pm – Outside of the front entrance

• **Riverview Junior-Senior High School** – 2:30pm - 3:00pm – Outside of the front entrance

3. <u>Food Services Update</u> - The Child Nutrition waivers implemented by the federal government are set to expire on June 30th, 2022. These waivers have provided important flexibility to school districts for meal distribution during the pandemic. One of the most important waivers was the Seamless Summer Food Program (SSO). This program has made it possible for *all* students to receive free meals (both breakfast and lunch) regardless of income status. The federal government seems hesitant to consider an extension to this waiver into the 2022-

2023 school year, but we will let you know this information as we receive it. In the meantime, however, please be aware that if this waiver expires, meals will no longer be free and *eligible families will then be subject to complete free/reduced meal applications again in order to qualify for free/reduced meals*. Currently, the only exception is the Verner Elementary School (this school operates under the Community Eligibility Provision and receives free meals due to their economic status).
