

## Dear Riverview Parents!

Good afternoon! We hope you are well and continue to enjoy the warm weather. As you know, we are in the home stretch of the 21-22 school year, if you can believe it! Below are a few items for your consideration:

- 1. <u>Covid Update</u> As you know, Covid cases are rising in <u>Allegheny</u> <u>County</u>. Although we have yet to reach "high" transmission, we want to remind everyone that we will continue to take a symptoms-based approach and do our best to balance the educational needs of the students while mitigating the spread of the virus. We are experiencing a few cases each week in our schools. If this worries you, please encourage your child to wear a mask. If your child is experiencing *any* symptoms, please be on the safe side and keep them home, consult your primary physician, and keep in close contact with our health staff. Remember that the health staff are here to support you, so please be respectful and work collaboratively with them to support your child, your family, and the rest of our school community. Below are the current recommendations set forth by the CDC:
  - Students may choose to wear a mask at any time as an additional precaution to protect themselves and others
  - Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines
  - Get tested if you have symptoms (every Riverview school has rapid and PCR tests on hand, and can be administered with parental consent)
  - Wear a mask if you have symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19
  - Wear a mask on public transportation
  - If students are at <u>high risk for severe illness</u>, consider wearing a mask indoors in public and taking additional precautions
