1. <u>2021-2022 Selection Survey</u> – Remember, we need **all selection surveys to be completed by this Sunday evening** in order to prepare for next year. There were some inquiries about the vaccination questions and here is our reason for asking: if the current quarantine protocols are still required for next year, knowing who is vaccinated keeps us from sending students home for multiple days and also relieves us from reporting those quarantines to the County Health Department. The information will be kept confidential and helps us with the logistics of contact tracing, which is an extremely difficult and detailed process. Railroad, left onto James St., left onto Allegheny River Boulevard, left onto Pennsylvania Ave., right onto the school access road and around the school.
