We hope you are well. As you can imagine, we are busy in preparation and excited for the start of the school year. We hope you are as well. We have a couple important items for your consideration this week:

- <u>Board Meetings / Board Elections</u> As you may have heard, the Board has moved their August meetings back one week to August 22nd, at 7pm, in the 10th Street Auditorium (study session) and August 29th, at 7pm, in the 10th Street Auditorium (voting meeting). This is to allow for additional time for candidates to apply for the publicized open board seat. Being a Board member, although not easy, is an honorable way to serve the students in our communities. If you feel like yourself, or someone you know, would make an excellent board member, please encourage them to apply. Details are included on the <u>School Board</u> tab of our District website.
- 2. <u>Free and Reduced Lunch</u> In the last two years, the federal government subsidized our food services program, which allowed for Districts to provide free lunches to all students. This year, we return to the traditional free and reduced lunch program, which requires eligible families to complete an online application to qualify for this benefit. The 2022-2023 Household letter will be sent to all families and is also included on the Food Service tab of the District website, as well as instructions for eligible families to apply.
- 3. <u>Paraprofessionals</u> We are in great need of paraprofessionals in each of our buildings. As previously stated, this is a noteworthy position and is essential to our efforts to provide a supportive educational environment for students. The hours are flexible and work well with most schedules. If you, or anyone you know, might be a good candidate for this position, please let us know right away! We really need the help! Thank you in advance for helping us to fill these important positions.
