

Nicholas is a 1989 graduate of Riverview and entered the Army after graduation. He served 22 years in the Armed Forces, earning 42 different certifications across a multitude of fields.

Over his career, he served in the John F. Kennedy Special Warfare Center, 112th Special Operations Signal Battalion, Special Operations command- Korea, 7th Special Forces Group, F-Company 51st Infantry Long Range surveillance, 30th Engineer Battalion, Iraqi Assistance Group, 96th Civil Affairs Battalion, and the 3rd Special Forces Group.

As a veteran of the Iraqi War, he was individually selected by the Department of Defense to conduct a Counter Insurgency mission in Iraq. After graduating from the Phoenix Academy in Iraq, Nicholas worked for the Iraqi Assistance Group at Combat Out Post Resolve. He assisted in the capturing of 32 terrorists on direct action missions. Under his team's supervision, the Kurdish battalion captured and processed 276 terrorists in one year. He has also served in Kuwait, Kurdistan, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Korea, Tunisia, Egypt, Okinawa, Japan, and Thailand.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal, four Army Commendation Medals, the Joint Service Achievement Medal, six Army Achievement Medals, seven Good Conduct Medals, two National Defense Service Medals, the Korean Defense Service Medal, the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal and many more.

Nicholas currently lives in Fayetteville, North Carolina, with his wife and children. He works for the Program Executive Office for Command Control Communications Tactical as a System Architecture Data Production Analyst.




