- 3. Two goals that you have for yourself next year in English class (and why). This CANNOT be grades.
- 4. One thing that you are most proud of this year. It can be a project, a test, a skill you've developed, or a study strategy. This must relate to English class. Be specific and explain why this makes you proud!
- 5. One aspect that you would change about <u>your</u> performance in English class this year. If you could go back in time, what would you do differently, specifically?
- 6. Two of your favorite activities that you completed in English class (and why).
- 7. Two of your least favorite activities that you completed in English class (and why). How could we change these for next year?
- 8. One item of feedback as we plan next year's Honors English 8 class. Be specific and provide an explanation.
- 9. Conclusion—What are you doing this summer? What books/authors do you want to read? What will you miss about Jr High? What are you excited/nervous for in high school?
