

Mr. Lindeman's Courses

Dear students and parents, what follows are plans for work and studying that you can do for the next two weeks while our normal school schedule is disrupted. Obviously this is not ideal but I have attempted to give you meaningful assignments that will help us all to keep moving forward in our learning. Your challenge will be to do all of this while on your own. The good news is that I will be available if you have questions, all you have to do is email me at rlindeman@rsd.k12.pa.us and I will answer you as quickly as possible.

Read the assignments and instructions carefully that have been handed out or emailed to your school email, there will be writing that you must do and email to me or Ms. Muckian as well as work that you will turn in when we return to our normal school schedule. Please be thorough in your work, imagine you can hear Ms. Muckian or I gently asking you to “say more” or “explain what you mean by that” as you write. The rule should be that more is better!

There are several components that will be sent via email to student's accounts. Be SURE you check your email on a regular basis (daily) so that you receive any assignments, extra help, or other resources that we will be sending.

Please observe the due dates and make sure you get the writing we are assigning turned in ontime so that we can get it graded and entered into the gradebook system.

A Special Note to AP Students and Parents: at the moment we have NO information that suggests the College Board will change the testing dates. In the past they have not moved those dates when there have been cases of natural disaster or other interruptions to school. That said, we have not had a circumstance quite like this. It is best to assume that the AP tests will stay in early May and thus we are preparing for that event. The work that you do while we are out of school will make a significant contribution to your preparedness for the test and final exams. This is obviously not ideal but we will work through it and I will be sending you more materials in the coming days.

Recent American History

Week 1 - 2

You will be working with the Civil Rights project, the information was passed out in class before the closure. Refer to the assignment and particularly refer to the grading rubric so that you are doing the best job possible. The project is due on Monday, March 30, 2020.

APUSH

Week 1

Read and Outline chapter 24 and complete the reading guide we handed out before we left. Do the reading guide questions on either a word processing document or in the notebooks you were given but be sure they are separate from other materials because you will be turning these in to be checked. Respond to all questions in sentence form! In AMSCO, review “Truman and the Cold War” and then complete the questions on pages 574-578 on your document or in your notebook.

I will also be emailing some links to video/media resources that will help you in understanding the information. Be sure to check your email so that you get those links!

By Thursday you should be done with chapter 24 and begin chapter 25. The instructions are exactly the same.

Week 2

Complete chapter 25 by Tuesday and review AMSCO “The Eisenhower Years” and then answer the questions on pages 595-599, again in your document or notebook.

Then begin working on chapter 26, with the same instructions for notes and reading guides. Review AMSCO “Promise and Turmoil” and then answer the questions on pages 619-624 in your document or notebook.

AP Psychology

Week 1
