- Many thanks to the PTO for the shirts!!
- There was a nice attendance for the Principles Coffee recently held. Thanks to all who attended.
- The $5^{\text {th }}$ grade just completed their field trip to Lutherlyn. Next year thinking about possibly changing trip from 2 days to 1 . The reason for the change is that students spend too much time on the bus and some of the activities are repetitive to other activities completed throughout the year. Nonetheless, the students have a great time and are grateful to attend.
- There has been a lot of headway in the construction projects over the last month. The railings in front of the school were completed. The replacement of the windows is a long process but they are coming along nicely. With the window
replacement, the drop ceiling also needs work as well as the window seals. The ballistic film will be added when installation is completed.
- The front office renovation has had some delays but is coming along. When completed there will be three buzzers in order to get into the school building- one at the door, one at office window and one for the hallway.
