- After School Enrichment: Jessica Condron, Carrie DelRosso Jessica - Art: need fingerprint clearance for teacher, so a little hold up on timing. Mr. Z to follow up with Miss Nancy. Will wait to send home flyer for now, may start later than February 7; will use art room this time. Yoga will run again in February and April for fourweek sessions each. 4. Principal's Report Mr. Z discussed the following items:

- Thank you for the holiday gifts!
- Lockdown drill went OK, but will do it again and more frequently so kids don't get scared and understand it better. Situations like these are becoming more common so need to be efficient and safe in case of an emergency.
- Snow delays and cancellations have been annoying, sorry, but now we will have school on the Monday after Easter.
- Online grade books - teachers were not using it correctly and still working on the printed version to be better. Online working OK.
- Wellness report - 30 day squat challenge for kids and teacher, indoor recess happening, but outdoor recess starting to come back as clean up begins.
