## Tenth Street PTO Meeting Minutes:

1. Call to order: $6: 32 \mathrm{pm}$
2. Welcome and Introduction by parents and teachers in attendance.

## 3. Officer's Reports

a. President - Welcome by Lisa DeVita and thank you for coming to the first meeting of the school year.
b. Secretary - Jeanine Franciscus Presented Treasurer's Report Motion to approve by Carrie Longstreth

- Check request forms are available for anyone who needs them through out the year.
- Stefanie Vespi (past Treasurer) spoke and said that the Accounting Firm that we are working with says we need to have a strong paper trail and two people should count any money being turned in and sign off on it before it goes to the Treasurer.
- We will continue to consult with the firm to make sure everything is on the up-and-up; we are following good processes, and must always have receipts.
- Past Treasurer and Current Treasurer will put together a more thorough report like last years financials as we go into the new year.
c. Vice President - Laurie Sliben - we have finalized the list of Committee chairs and volunteers and that list has been distributed. We also have a list of the at-large volunteers ready to help.
d. Secretary - Approval of May meeting minutes - motion to approve: Paula Tomlinson - $1^{\text {st }}$ and Stefanie Vespi - $2^{\text {nd }}$.

4. Principal's Report - Mr. Z discussed the following items with his own agenda.

- New projects - Carpeting and concrete work has been completed. Painting will also be done in the auditorium. Outside of building caps to be painted this Fall.
- Tree on Ninth Street not in good condition; have been discussing with the neighbor how to manage it. Decided to have a dead limbs removed at neighbor's cost (it's on his property, but hangs over the school's sidewalk) on Columbus Day.
- New Staff Members - Ms. Roderick - $4^{\text {th }}$ Grade, Ms. Serrao - $3^{\text {rd }}$ Grade, Ms. Wiesniewski - First Grade Classroom Aide. Had 400 applications, interviewed 60 and called back 8 and all were good.
- Need One Class III Paraprofessional and One Computer Labe Aide as our current one is moving to Verner.
- New Director of Student Achievement and Special Ed position needed.
- New Initiatives - Video security at the front office is in effect. Sprigeo - Bully Prevention effort - will be an online form on school website so that anyone can report an incident anonymously or otherwise. November 11 is Veterans Day and would like to do something special to honor Veterans, maybe a special breakfast or Flag raising, etc. Literacy Night will be held and will be as big as an Open House Night. And author will come to speak during the day to the kids and an evening presentation of some kind as well. Twitter account has been set up and we are Tweeting, to add to the communication, but there will be no commenting. A Wellness Committee will be formed. We are a little behind on this as compared to other districts. This would be a nutrition-based program for kids, too much candy/treats in school, cafeteria staff will be involved as well. Need a plan with parameters. First meeting is 9.20 .16 at 9 am and all are welcome to attend.
- SWPBIS - Thank you for your PAWSitive photos of kids during the summer. They are posted in the hallways. Continuing with the 200 board, hoping to get grant money, have assemblies, do some fun Lip Dub videos with the kids, and will host the Carnival again this year.
- Meet the Teacher/Curriculum Night was a success. Thank you for your flexibility will adjust schedule and maybe hold it the second week next year so it's easier on parents.
- Email regarding Police presence at the High School - using Go EduStar system to put out those kinds of pieces of information. RE: rabid raccoon on school grounds near park. The system is a good way to communication quickly with everyone in the event of something like this, but please make sure the school has the correct email for you so that you receive these notices/emails.
- YMCA is doing a survey regarding Before/After School Care program to gauge interest and need for our district. Last time they did this not enough parents were interested. Will see how it goes this time. Verner also received the surveys.
