
### Mrs. Poth: All classes plans for April 15-17:

#### Week 5 goals

### Spanish I:

- 3) Read <u>Pobre Ana Chapter 4</u>. A good review of food vocabulary and new terms for places in the community. Quiz next week.
- 4) Complete **CORE WB pages 87 and 89** (carefully translate sentences to choose the right word/verb). \* We will review page 89 on Thursday.
- 5) Choose 5 party related words from the chapter and write 5 sentences in Spanish.

## Spanish II:

- 1) Continue reading <u>El viaje</u> through **chapter 3** ( Good chapter to learn the preterit verbs and review vocab.)

- 3) Review vocabulary for <u>chapter 3</u>. SPANISH II <u>QUIZLET</u> class and complete two additional activities on the <u>irregular preterit</u>. (I receive notifications)
- 4) Go to the Realidades Textbook Site and <u>Complete the 2 vocabulary activities</u>, write responses in your notebook.

- 3) **Focus** on the past tenses (imperfect/preterit) in this story of <u>Los tres cerditos</u>. **Listen** to the audio as you read. Write **3 examples each** of when the preterit is used and the imperfect in this story.
- 4) CORE workbook Crossword, Horizontal clues only.(write in notebook)
- 5) QUIZIZZ game may be sent, or we will do activities in class Thursday. Please attend
- 6) Submit Google Form, include photos of work.

# Spanish IV:

- 1) Go to the <u>Spanish Video Playlist</u>: Watch the **4th and 5th** video on the Imperfect Subjunctive.
- 2) Go to the online textbook linked on the <u>Padlet</u>. Select **More**, **Unidad 5** and choose <u>Imperfect Subjunctive or Present</u>. Complete **all activities** on the page. Use the video at the top to scroll through (hit play) to read each screen/description.
- 3) Go to QUIZLET (make sure you are logged into our class) and **complete two activities** to practice the verbs. I will get notifications.
- 4) <u>CNNenespanol</u>. Find an article on CNN that interests you, read it, and share the link and a brief opinion/takeaway from it. Try to find something related to PBL or related to Spain or anything of interest.

- 5) Spend time working on PBL, take notes or use Wakelet to save online resources. Look at the <u>SDGs</u> in particular and see what you come up with that can connect with Spanish and current events. Post on Flipgrid, where you are with your PBL.
