Several southwestern Pennsylvania high schools were named among the best in the United States by U.S. News & World Report's latest ranking.

Upper St, Clair was the top in the Pittsburgh region at No. 400 on U.S. News' "Best High Schools" list published Tuesday. It was ranked as a "gold" school that measures the percentage of people who are preparing students for college.

The top high school in Pennsylvania was Julia R. Masterman Laboratory and Demonstration School, which ranked No. 60. The next nearest was New Hope Solebury High School, which was ranked No. 210.
