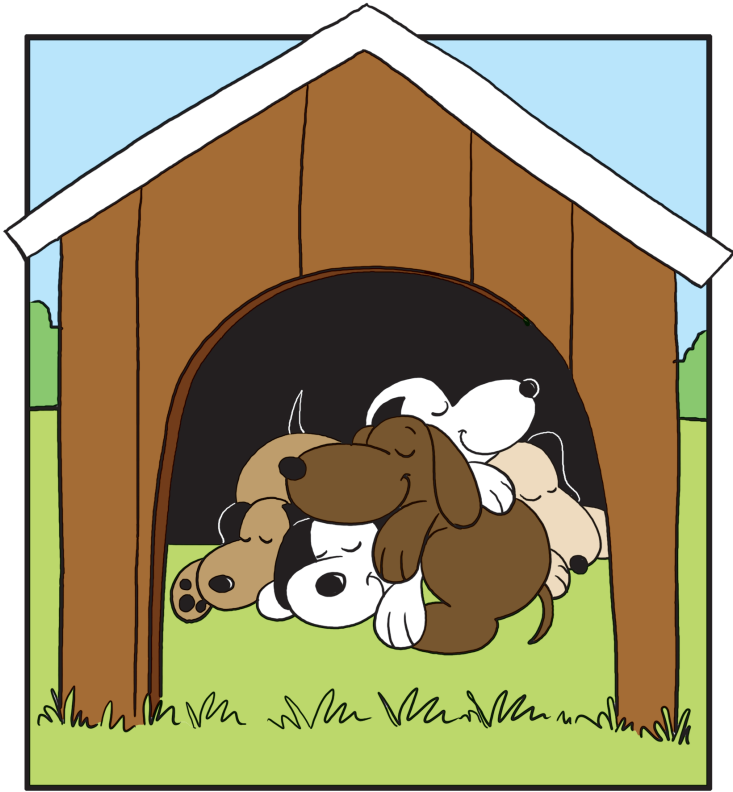

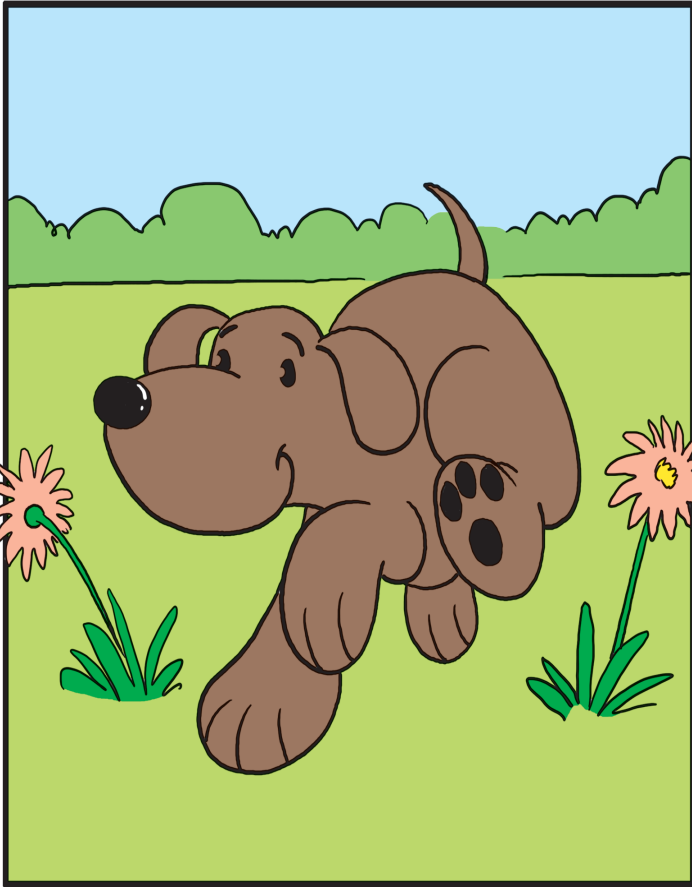


Count the brown puppies in the doghouse.

her mouth looks like a smile.



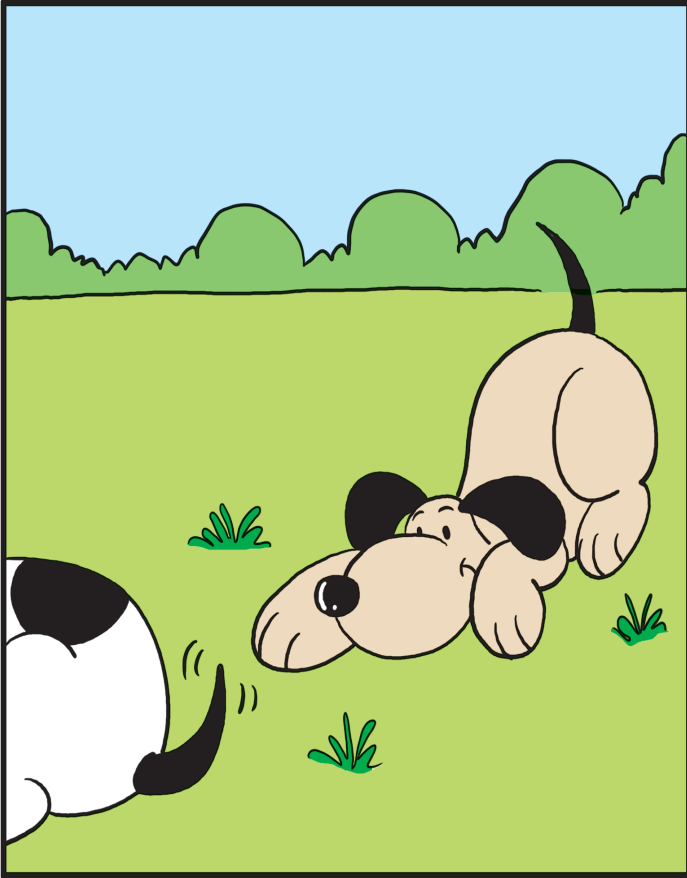
Pickle is a little grouchy and a little slow.

Did he just gobble a sour ball?

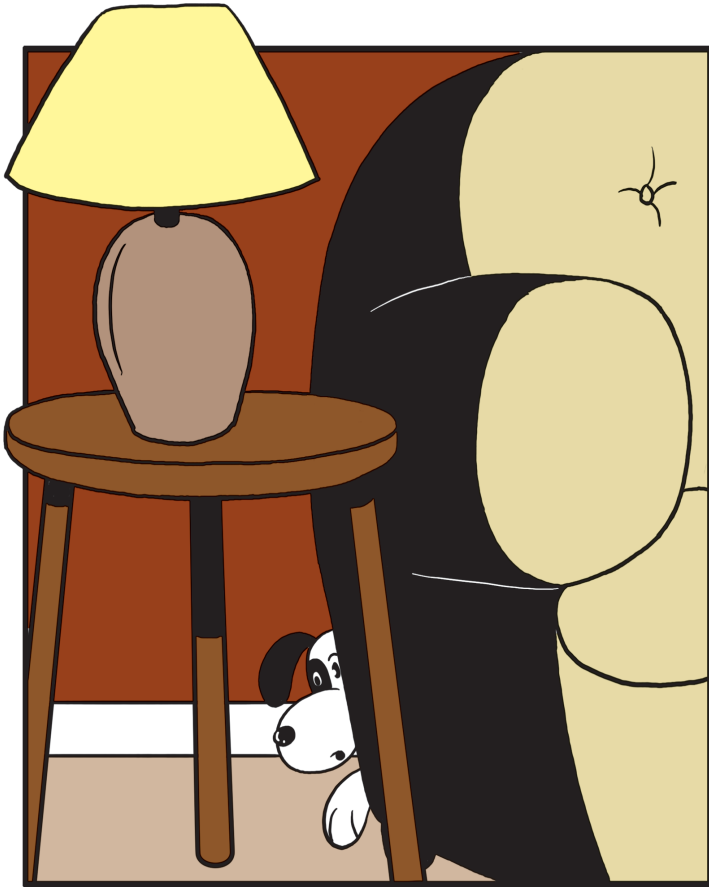
Or maybe he needs a nice nap.



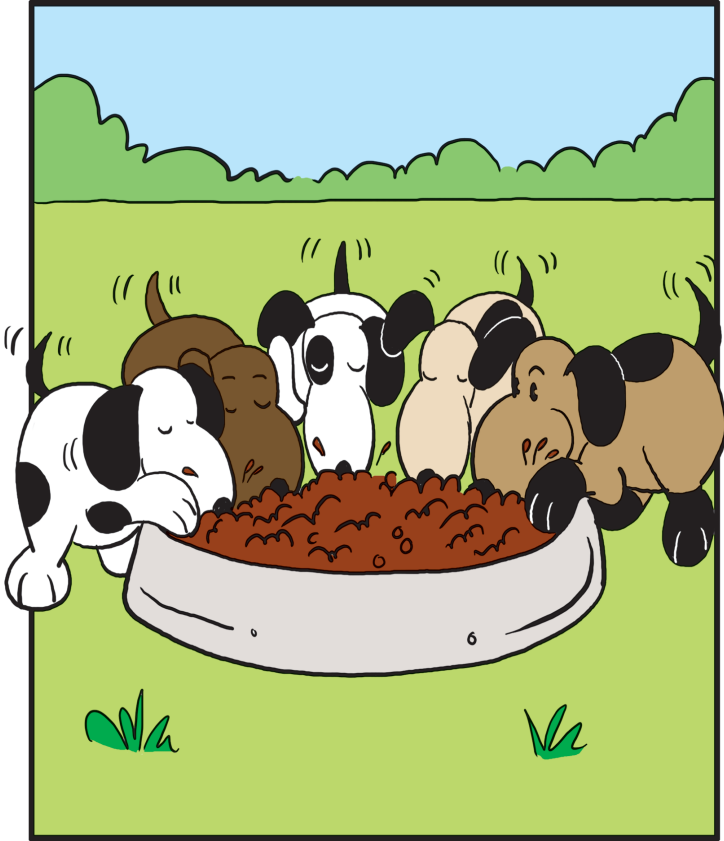
Bow Wow is able to bark loudly.
