Directions: Students will use the week to further develop last week's Expository Essay Rough Draft so it is ready for "Publication" by Friday. They will follow the daily lessons below and post all work in MS Teams by Friday, May 1 (unless technical difficulties arise and email works better).

Students will also complete a new vocabulary unit this week, Vocabulary Power Plus Level 7 Lesson 10 (VL 10). I will be sending out a link to the VL 10 Quizlet. It is my preference that students complete the vocabulary drills through the Quizlet website rather than using the paper packets going forward. However, if there are any students/families who would prefer the paper exercises over the Quizlet drills, please email me, and I will send you a copy of the VL 10 PDF.

- Complete Quizlet VL 10 Flashcards
- On your completed Rough Draft, please use the highlight function to label the Thesis Statement and Topic Sentences in YELLOW and your Signal Words in GREEN (your highlighting will remain through publication). Re-read these sentences checking for focus and style, and revise as needed.

- Complete Quizlet VL 10 Learn
- Review and revise your draft for Content Development - Reread each paragraph to make sure that you have given as much detail as necessary to fully develop your idea. Also check to make sure that you did not include too much information or lose track of your focus along the way. Add or remove information along the way.

Day 33 (4-29):

- Complete Quizlet VL 10 Write
- Today, you'll be revising for Organization. Here you should be sure that you have a clearly defined introductory paragraph (not just a Thesis Statement alone), a distinct body, and a focused conclusion. You should also review the beginning of each of your sentences to make sure they flow smoothly from one to the next.

- Complete Quizlet VL 10 Match or Gravity
- Editing Day. Review and edit your essay for common errors in grammar, usage, spelling, sentence structure, etc. Please be sure that you did not use first-person (I, me, my, mine, etc.) or second-person (you, your, yours) in your essay!
