


Dear students and parents,

## AP Literature and Composition 12 – March 30 - April 3

**PART 1:** Students should complete the weekly USA Test Prep Assignment that is listed in their online class. Students will need to use the Account ID listed below, and they will also need their login and password. If they forget this information, they should send me an email or Remind message, and I will provide it.

If a student did not complete the USA Test Prep assignments from the first two weeks of our absence period, they can (and should) still complete these. Grades will be entered on Saturday, April 4th in the morning.

**PART 2:** Students in the class had a choice between reading one of two dystopian novels, *1984* by George Orwell (297 pages) or *Brave New World* by Aldous Huxley (268 pages).

In either case, *students have been expected to read approximately 15 pages per school day and work towards the completion of a Major Works Data Sheet (MWDS) each day.* They were provided with a hard copy of the MWDS in class on 3/13. Their analyses on the MWDS should be thoughtful, original, and specific.

If a student has lost this document, needs another copy, or was not present to receive it on 3/13, they should email me or send me a message through Remind to receive a new copy.

**If the student is able, they should send a picture of the MWDS completion to this point (at the beginning of the week (on 3/30 if possible)).**

By the end of this week (April 3), each student should be approximately 75% of the way through the reading and completion of the MWDS. **They can send another photo/set of photos at the end of the week to document their progress.**

**PART 3:** Students should complete Vocabulary Lesson (VL 18) this week - either in the packet or via Quizlet. Grades for VL 18 Quizlet will be entered on Saturday, April 4th in the morning.
