Activity Directions

ABC Order: Write your words in ABC Order.

<u>Pyramid Words:</u> Write your spelling words in a pyramid shape. Start with the first letter. ON the next line write the first two letters. On the next line write the first three letters. Continue until you have written the entire word.

boar
board

<u>Take a Spelling Test:</u> Number a paper from 1-15. Have someone read you the list like your teacher would do while you write the words. Practice any words you missed!

Story Words: Write a story using all (or as many as you can) of your spelling words.

<u>Trace Around:</u> Write each of your spelling words using a pencil. Then, trace around each word with a crayon, colored pencil, or a marker.
