1. **Master Planning** – In the last ten years, the District has upgraded our buildings to ensure they are safe and sustainable. We are now working on master planning, which means carefully looking at our building capacity, costs, grade bands, efficiencies, etc., for the purpose of finding efficient and appropriate options to educate our students for years to come. 3. **Riverview YouTube Channel** – We've started rebranding the [District YouTube channel](#). Here, we will house videos related to our schools, such as School Board meetings, RVTV, morning announcements, and videos of school events and activities. Our boy's cross-country team has won the WPIALS for the second year straight, and three of our cross country girls, as well as all of the boys, are heading to the PIAA competition! 7. **Upcoming Event: Nicotine Prevention, Control, Treatment – On November 13, 2024, from 6-7:30pm in the 10th St. Auditorium**, we are offering a parent information session from Adagio Health and Dr. Chu (who is a renowned researcher from the University Pittsburgh). This session will review youth vaping, nicotine and tobacco use statistics, as well as examine devices and products youth are using and where they may be hiding them. We will also discuss how Big Tobacco targets our youth through design, flavors, marketing, and social media.
