said Mom.

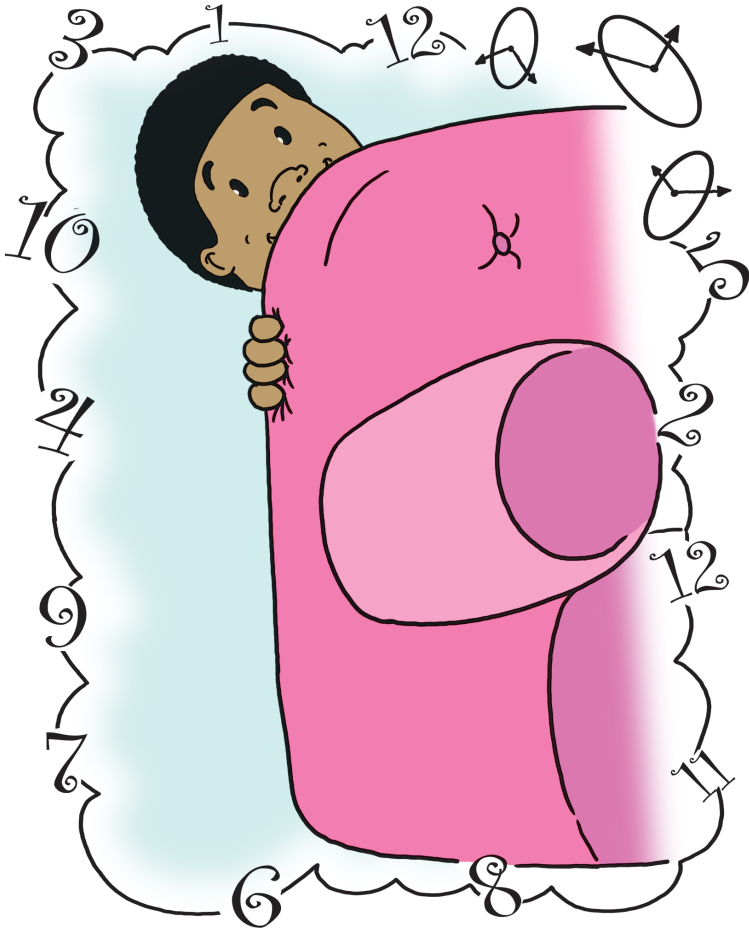


"Is it time to count?"
